New River Community College

The college closed its major remote academic site located inside of the New River Valley Mall (now called Uptown Christiansburg) due to the March 13 National Emergency Declaration and Governor's Order. At the time of the closure the site had an in-class headcount of 898 students, accounting for 409.3 FTES. The college closed the site because it could not guarantee proper cleaning and sanitizing necessary for the COVID-19 virus at the time. The site was closed for the remainder of Spring Semester 2020 and all of Summer Semester 2020. The site reopened with a very limited number of students for Fall Semester 2020 on September 1.
