NRCC credit is awarded only for documented learning that is equivalent to specific subjects at the college and closely parallels the experiences and outcomes required by a college course. NRCC provides students with the opportunity to receive CPL through the CDA while maintaining the integrity and rigor of our academic program. The application for CPL in Early Childhood Development must be reviewed and approved by the early childhood faculty and the academic dean. The early childhood faculty may approve CPL be changed to a different NRCC course based on the student's workplace experiences and CDA portfolio documentation.

A grade of "T" will be assigned on the student's NRCC transcript for the early childhood course awarded with CPL. The grade will not be counted in the student's GPA. While CPL awarded by NRCC satisfies NRCC curricular requirements, it may not transfer to four-year institutions. Students who intend to transfer are advised to review the institution's policies and guidelines on CPL credit. The way credit is accepted or applied varies by institution.
